Title: Branch Assistant - West Salem

Job Responsibilities: Under general supervision, the Branch Assistant charges library materials in and out, assists with routing and shelving materials, collects fines, and provides assistance to patrons.

Illustrative Duties: Performs all branch related functions, including but not limited to; opening and closing the library, cash register operation, processing daily delivery of library materials, providing reference services, and assisting patrons in the general use of the library and its equipment. May provide programs and/or conduct story time at various outreach locations, and within the branch.

Qualifications: High school diploma or equivalent, library experience preferred. The ability to push, pull, bend, lift and twist with ease. May require sitting or standing for long periods of time. Must be able to properly lift up to 50 lbs.

Working Conditions: Part-time, approximately 20 hours per week.

Ability to work a flexible schedule including evenings and weekends is required.

Skills and Abilities: Presents a positive, professional image to the public; interacts and responds appropriately to patrons and staff; develops and maintains effective working relationships with supervisor, staff, and volunteers; communicates effectively in written and oral form; maintains confidentiality.
