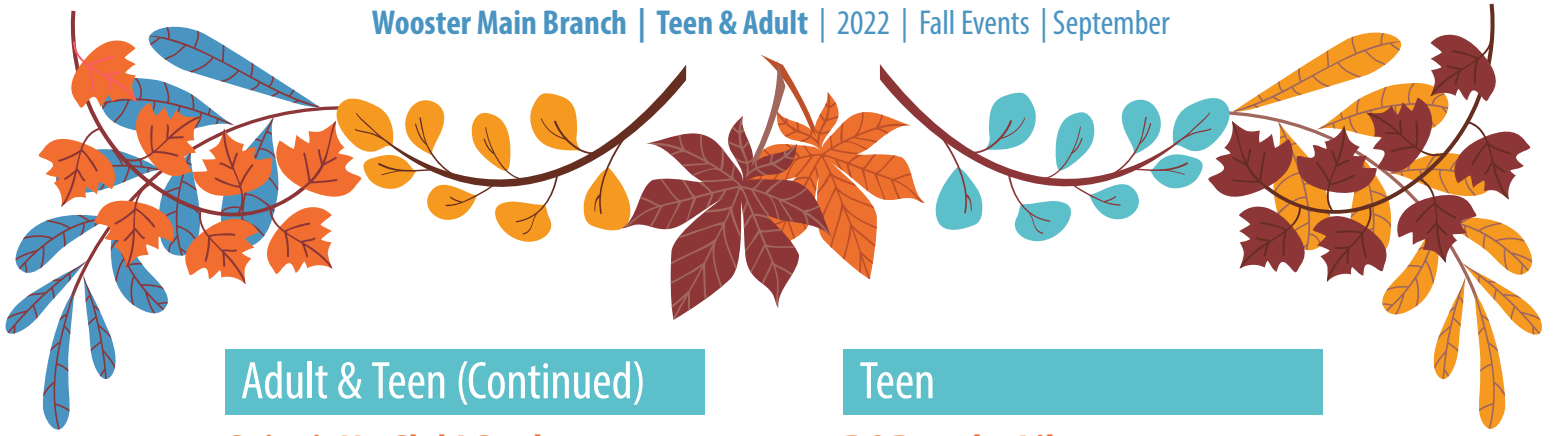


Tuesday Crafternoon: Pretty Heart Tote Bag
