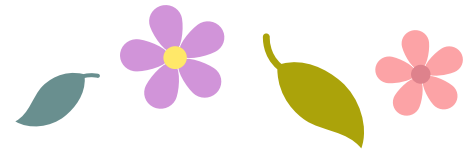

Personalized 3D Printed Key Chain

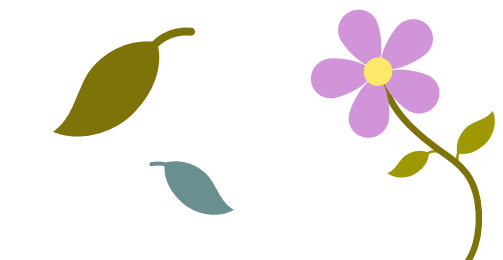
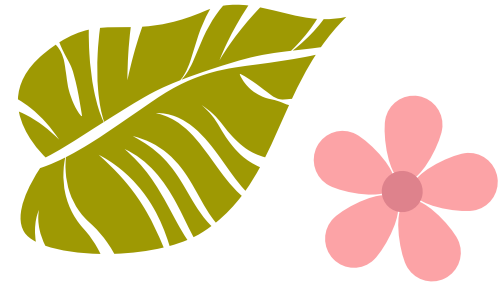
Tuesday, May 16 from 4:30 PM to 5:30 PM
