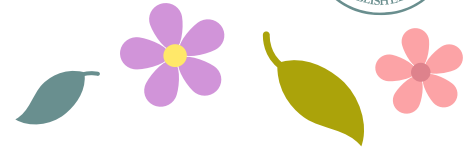


# Spring Events 2023

### Personalized 3D Printed Key Chain

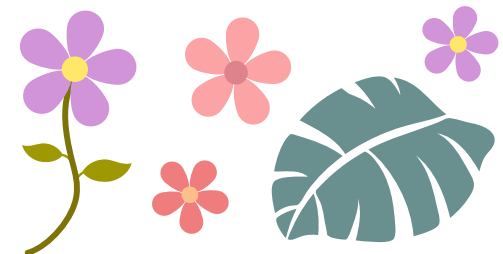
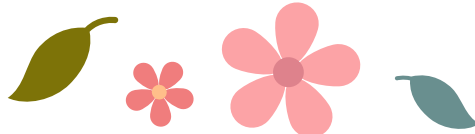
Tuesday, April 4 from 6 – 7 PM
