December's book is *Spinning Silver* by Naomi Novik. Registration required.

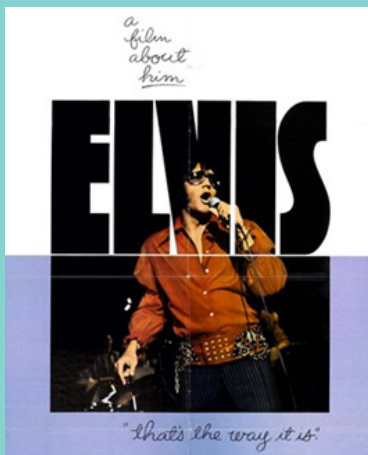
