Book Club

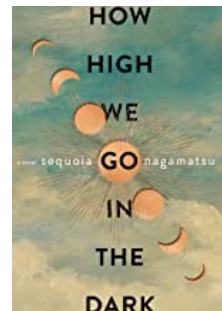
Thursdays at 1 PM
